#### APM2023/3 Annual Report of the Gate & Upper Helmsley Parish Council:

"Over the last twelve months the main issues, which have been discussed are -

- Back Lane possible closure for traffic coming in from the York End. NYCC did a letter drop of sixty letters, twenty responses were received, with fourteen for and 6 against, so NYCC said not the support for a full public consultation. As a village we have missed a chance!
- Defib/Pub unfortunately, the pub is still closed and the power was turned off to defib, unknown to
  us, so it got damp and wont work. Fortunately, RDC the Rural Community Grant scheme provided
  funds for a new one, which is now sited on the Village Hall. Thanks to Jon for sourcing and fitting
  the defib.
- Opposite and front of BATA Neither NYCC or City of York Council seem to want to do anything
  regarding the area opposite, which turns into a mud bath when wet. We managed to get Keep
  Clear put in front of BATA, but everyone just ignores it! They did manage to turn up and mend all
  the bollards in the middle of the A166, which were in desparate need of attention.
- Website is being developed at the moment
- Sue Panesar has joined the Parish Council and it was good to have all the places filled, then Janet Buckley decided to stand down, so I would like to thank Janet for all her years of service on the council and for doing several years as clerk before becoming a councillor.
- I would like to thank all the councillors for their attendance and Fiona for all she does as Parish Clerk/RFO"
