of steps from the road up to the village hall but it might be 2020 before this is done as funding will need to be secured. An application has been made, however, the pot for 2018/19 is already allocated, hence the 2020 date.

I'm very pleased with the outcomes and hope they have your support. Please contact me if you have any queries.

Public Session - The Parish Council will, time permitting, adjourn the council 19/18 meeting for a short time to allow for public comment and questions:

It was asked if there had been any response from NYCC re the increased volume of traffic on 166 and through Buttercrambe caused by the new housing development at Stamford Bridge - C goodrick informed that she had raised the issue with NYCC and was awaiting a response. She also informed that Full Sutton Prison had applied for planning for 6 x 5 storey buildings that would house a further 1440 prisoners. This would add an even greater volume of traffic to the A166.

It was agreed that the PC should comment on the Full Sutton prison extension expressing their concern at the lack of a traffic management plan for the A166 and the massive increase in traffic already caused by the developments at Stamford Bridge that will only be made worse by expansion of Full Sutton Prison.

It was raised that the footpath from Cottage Gardens to the A166 is made very narrow with grass covering probably half the width of it making it inaccessible for wheelchair users and mothers with prams. The footpath is near a busy road and used to get to the bus stop and for children to get the school bus:

The PC agreed we would contact highways to ask if they would clear the path. (CG suggested contacting Andrew Stanton Area 4 Highways)
